**MATTHEW COCHRAN** is Instructor of Guitar at Interlochen Arts Academy. He performs early music, new music, popular music and unpopular music. His recordings have been featured on National Public Radio's "Classical Guitar Alive" and "Guitar Journeys," and he has appeared at concert series and festivals throughout the United States, Europe and Canada, including Weill Hall, the Guitar Foundation of America, the New York Guitar Seminar at Mannes, the Troubadour Series, Mostly Music Chicago, Iserlohn Guitar Symposium (Germany), Silesian Guitar Autumn (Poland) and Acadia Guitar Festival (Canada). Dr. Cochran's recordings have been released on the Clear Note and Soundset labels, and his work as an audio engineer has appeared on National Public Radio, Public Radio International and BBC. From 2014-2015 Dr. Cochran hosted Goes2Eleven, the popular podcast about the world of the guitar. He holds a doctorate in guitar performance from Florida State University, and Master of Music and Bachelor of Music degrees in Guitar Performance from the Eastman School of Music. His primary teachers were Bruce Holzman and Nicholas Goluses.
