JOHN BRAGLE is the Conductor of the Interlochen Arts Academy Choir and Chamber Singers, Instructor of Voice, and is also the Director of the World Youth Honors Choir and Festival Choir at Interlochen Arts Camp. Choirs under his direction have performed in Lincoln Center's Alice Tully Hall, DAR Constitution Hall in Washington D.C., Detroit's Orchestra Hall, the Harris Theater in Chicago, and DeVos Hall in Grand Rapids. He is a cum laude graduate of Michigan State University with a bachelor's degree in Music Education and also received a master's degree in Choral Conducting from MSU. Bragle has served as Director of Choirs at Williamston Community Schools, visiting professor of music at Northwest Michigan College, director of the Michigan State University Youth Treble Ensemble and assistant director of the Michigan State University Men's Glee Club. His conducting studies have been with Charles Smith, David Rayl and Jonathan Reed, and voice studies with Richard Fracker and Robert Bracey.

ANDY EVANS was raised in Cedar, Michigan, and graduated from Michigan State University with a B.A. in Music and a M.A. in Educational Technology. He played as a freelance artist in Nashville, Tennessee for eight years and taught 5th-8th grade orchestra for three years for Metropolitan Nashville public schools. While in Nashville, Evans performed with numerous groups including The 5th Dimension, Gary U.S. Bonds, The Nashville Jazz Orchestra, The Establishment Big Band, The Roland Gresham Trio, Vassar Clements, Annie Sellick, and Al Delory and Salsa en Nashville. Evans performs regularly with many of Traverse City's top musicians in many diverse musical settings. In addition to performing, Evans currently directs five choirs grades 6-12 and teaches 5th grade general music at Kingsley Area Schools.

ROB STOW is known for his energetic and holistic approach to making vocal and choral music. He is Director of Choirs at Elk Rapids Schools. Stow has conducted many different choirs and musical productions at the University of Michigan, Michigan State, the Old Town Playhouse in Traverse City, and others. He also conducted a choir that toured Europe in 2006 featuring students from across the state of Michigan. Stow's choirs have qualified for State Solo and Ensemble and/or State Choral Festival. He has been the Music Director of the High School Contemporary Musical Theatre Showcase at Interlochen Arts Camp. Stow holds a B.M. in Music Education from the University of Michigan, B.A. in English from the University of Michigan, and a M.M. in Choral Conducting from Michigan State University
