Siwon [see-one] Kim, a native of Seoul, South Korea, is recognized for her “masterful musicality and distinctive sound” (*The Segye Times*). Her dynamic stage presence has captivated audiences across prestigious concert venues in North America, Europe, and Asia, including Mariinsky II, Musashino Hall, Harbin Concert Hall, the Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall, Hill Auditorium, Kumho Art Hall, and Universal Arts Center.

She transitions seamlessly between roles as a guest artist, faculty member, and judge, regularly receiving invitations to international festivals and competitions such as the Toradze International Festival, Harbin Piano Festival, Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp, Oklahoma Baptist University Keyboard Festival, Michigan City Chamber Music Festival, and Stickley Piano Competition.

She has performed as a soloist with orchestras worldwide, including South Bend Symphony, the Mariinsky Orchestra, and Ann Arbor Symphony. From 2017 to 2022, she performed as the piano duo partner of Maestro Alexander Toradze.

Siwon Kim has won numerous prizes at competitions, including The Segye Times Competition, The Sunhwa Music Concours, Concours, Music International Grand Prix, Concert Artists International Competition, Eumak-Chunchu Competition, Samick-Beckstein Concours, Suri Music Concours, and W. Byrd International Piano Competition.

Siwon Kim began piano at age three in Seoul. She attended Sunhwa Arts School, then Seoul Arts High School, and Seoul National University. After moving to the United States, she earned an A.D. and M.M. at Indiana University South Bend and a D.M.A. at the University of Michigan under Prof. Arthur Greene, focusing on Prokofiev’s last piano sonata. Now based in South Bend, Indiana, Dr. Siwon Kim serves as an adjunct professor at Bethel University.
